Duties & Responsibilities:

St. James Lutheran Church has a rich history of liturgical worship and theological traditions. Music plays an intricate part of each service by supporting and encouraging the congregation.

Organist/Accompanist

- Plan weekly organ music as appropriate to liturgical season, readings of the day and festival days. Typically two services per week, (except for Advent/Lent/Holy Week). Regular services include one Sunday worship service and one Wednesday Eucharist service.
- Sunday service includes prelude, offertory, postlude and full liturgy. This may include selection of hymns to be sung during service.
- Wednesday Eucharist includes piano prelude and hymn accompaniment (service is in the Chapel).
- Accompany Choir in rehearsals and service. Choir rehearses Thursdays @ 7:15 9:00 pm and 8:45 am on Sundays.
- Submit selections and details for both services to church office at beginning of each week.

Chancel Choir Director

- Plan and prepare choral music as appropriate to liturgical season, readings of the day and festival days for all services.
- Direct choir at Thursday rehearsals (7:15-9pm), Sunday morning rehearsal (8:45am) and service (9:30-10:30am)
- Oversee cantor schedule and rehears soloists/special music as needed
- Prepare liturgical portions of service including psalmody, gospel acclamation and hymn review.
- Submit selections and details to church office at beginning of each week.
