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#### History

Since the year 2000, St. James Lutheran Church has received monies from the St. James Apartments which are used to fund scholarships for members. Each year, these scholarships have been awarded to St. James members pursuing higher education.

#### Eligibility

Applicants must be members of St. James Lutheran Church. Membership is defined by the St. James Lutheran Church Constitution section C8.01.:

C8.01. Members of this congregation shall be those baptized persons on the role of this congregation at the time that this constitution is adopted and those who are admitted thereafter and who have declared and maintain their membership in accordance with the provisions of this constitution and its bylaws.

Inactive membership as defined by the St. James Constitution is as follows:

Bylaw C8.05.05. Inactive members shall be defined as the failure to commune during the previous twenty-four months and/or failure to make a recorded contribution of time, talent, or money during the same twenty-four months.

Applicants must maintain their membership at St. James Lutheran Church throughout the duration of the school year to which the application applies.

#### **Use of Scholarship Monies**

The St. James Scholarship may be used for attending a 4-year college or university; a community college; or a trade school. Scholarships will not be provided for seminary students, post-graduate students pursuing religious studies, or students seeking postgraduate degrees. Scholarships to a St. James student member shall be available to the student for only four (4) school years. Reapplication by the student may occur to cover four school years.

A Financial Award granted to an applicant shall be <u>distributed only to the Scholarship</u> Recipient's college, <u>university</u>, <u>community college or trade school</u> and the school will then credit the Scholarship Recipient's account. No scholarship monies shall be distributed directly to the Scholarship Recipient.
